- I. In attendance:

 - Jane Beck, Kenny Daher and Selina Mach, Project Grad
- III. New Business:
 - a. Project Grad: Jane presented regarding the SEL and Academic Support that they are able to offer:
 - 1. Selina is purchasing books to read with Christy's class based on SEL traits, and will also cover the academic language involved. Selina and Kenny will work on who will help with science Tuesdays 2:30-3:20 beginning January 12th every other week. And Language Arts on Fridays beginning January 15th every other week. 2:30-3:20.
 - 2. Kenny will assist in dissecting a virtual lesson using mice and rats. Kenny's will begin his at 2 p.m. on Friday, January 8th (maybe over two days).
 - 3. Jim's will be a murder mystery for 90 minutes (10:30-noon on Fridays) twice a month (January 8th/22nd for example).
 - 4. Kenny offered to come over (after COVID) to help with skiing instruction, with Ski-Ku's zoom.
 - 5. Jane said that she will be sending board books for our students to enjoy and they cover Haida and Tlingit language instruction.
 - b. Fab Lab update: We have had the Fab Lab crew visit twice. The students have been learning how to make hooks for ice fishing, flint napping, painting (put into our virtual art show), cordage, built elephants, used 3D printer, among other activities. The kids are truly enjoying it!
 - c. AK Challenger upcoming: We will begin as soon as the new semester/COVID is back to normal.
 - d. Cultural Language -Tebughna Foundation: Vide Kroto has been doing an outstanding job. And Edna Standifer has been assisting the classes in person. We now meet 3 times a week (different cohorts)
 - e. Hydroponics – Starting: We have seeded the veggies and they are growing.

 - f. Salmon Project – Stages: Our eggs now have eyes! And Kenny has offered to do a Salmon growth lesson for us during his science.
 - g. MAPS testing - Winter: The testing runs until January 17th so we will begin when the kids return.

Pam called all parents re the Committee Meeting. The Parent Engagement now includes a meal going home to the family on Sunday, December 13th, along with song sheets to enjoy family time.
