School Profile:

Data from MAPS, iReady, and mClass were reviewed. For each assessment BOY and EOY data was compared, along with growth percentile data for MAPS. The MAPS data showed that students are making growth in both math and reading and are either surpassing or equally growing at the same rate, nationally, as other students. It was shared that even with the positive student growth that is happening we're continuing to focus on raising our percentile data, with more of an emphasis on reading than math because of the Alaska Reads Act.

With the addition of a new elementary teacher the secondary schedule had to be entirely changed to accommodate the use of space and support personnel. Students stayed in their same classes, with meeting times and locations differing for many classes.
