- ❖ **Community and Staff Present**

- ❖ **MAP Data:**
MAP assessments were just given to students last week and the results were shared. Growth, comparing fall to winter assessments, was given the most attention with some focus on achievement. Areas of higher and lower growth were discussed.
- ❖ **Path/Bridge updates:**
Notification was given that the blocks for the path will be moved on December 29 into the playground. It was shared that they would be stacked two high up against the fence adjacent to the ravine. Along with this information it was also shared that stacking the blocks double high might discourage kids from climbing on them. Mike suggested contacting Risk Management to get their okay with stacking the blocks.
- ❖ **2026-27 Draft Calendars:**
Two versions of the 2026-27 HOB calendar were shared. One version included more Saturday Schools with students getting out a few days earlier than the other version. After much discussion the calendar with less Saturday Schools was determined to be the better choice.
- ❖ **Cameras:**
Attendees were told about the VCCI decision to purchase cameras for our school grounds. Cameras will be placed so they capture the tar playground area between the buildings and from the entrance of the gym to the entrance of portable 3. This will allow the entrances to all buildings, not including the ATCO trailer, to be monitored. Currently, the district IT department is determining a plan to get the cameras purchased, with community funds, then having the installation completed by Borough Maintenance. Everything is a work in progress at this time, and no completion date has been determined.
- ❖ **KESA:**
KESA will be at Voznesenka School on the morning of December 18th, which is the last day of school before break. This will be preceded by the December fire drill. Students in the elementary classes will have an opportunity to see the emergency response vehicles and equipment that will be on site.

Parent/Teacher conferences will be held on January 21st. Schedules will be sent out after break, so please do your best to keep this date available.
- ❖ **Title 1:**
Julie Aurand talked with attendees about upcoming Title 1 events. Parents were asked about what they would like to see happen for the next event with several choices being suggested.
