### Site Council Meeting Minutes

January 15, 2026

- ❖ **Community and Staff Present**

- ❖ **Hunter Education:**  
An opportunity was presented for adult community members to become a Hunter Education Training instructor. Interested individuals would be required to attend a weekend session in Anchorage to complete the required training. Hotel, registration, and travel would all be covered expenses. After the training has been completed, there is a requirement to teach at least two Hunter Education Training program certifications each year.
- ❖ **Barrier/Bridge updates:**  
The barriers placed to create a path to the playground were removed. It was previously shared that these barriers would be placed in the playground, then used for the path to replace the bridge, but they were taken off site to be repurposed elsewhere. The path is now scheduled to be completed after the start of the 2027 fiscal year, which is July 1<sup>st</sup>.
- ❖ **Adult Education classes:**  
Adult Education classes will once again be offered at Voznesenka School, with an anticipated start date sometime this month. When this gets started, classes will be held on Tuesdays from 3:30-5:30. The expected topics covered will be GED preparation, English as a Second Language, and Computer Skills.
- ❖ **ACCESS testing:**  
This is an English Language Proficiency test, which is given to all students in kindergarten who are also Russian speakers. Dependent on test results, students determined to be English Language Learners are provided with certain accommodations and supports to help them with their learning. These students are then tested in subsequent years until they reach the determined level of proficiency that exits them from the program. As grade levels increase, the number of students taking the ACCESS test decreases.
- ❖ **Security Cameras:**  
The district has agreed to do the install, with the cost of the cameras and subsequent equipment being paid for by the VCCI. There isn't a set date for the installation, but the district has requested the tech department to put together an equipment list to obtain an estimate.
- ❖ **February events:**
  1. The week of February 2<sup>nd</sup> will be Spirit Week for our school. (Details forthcoming)
  2. A Title 1 Family Event will take place after school on February 5<sup>th</sup>. This will be followed by a movie night.
  3. Federal Programs night will take place on February 26<sup>th</sup> at HHS.
- ❖ **Voznesenka/Kachemak Selo School Board Report:**  
It was shared there will be a school board presentation for Voznesenka and Kachemak Selo Schools on Monday, April 6<sup>th</sup>. This takes place every three years and was scheduled last year to accommodate the yearly board presence at HHS. This does fall on the evening before a Holy Day. Mike apologized and understands there will be minimal presence from parents and community members.
