GROOMING THE FUTURE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Our Grooming the Future scholarship is available to KPBSD graduating high school seniors planning to attend or students currently enrolled in a Vocational Trade or certification program either physically or online. Scholarships will be given to the winners regardless of other grants or scholarships that the students may also receive.

Requirements are as follows:

1. The applicant must submit the completed application form.
2. The applicant must submit a cover letter. This letter must include a student photo, student introduction, and trade school name, address and the financial aids name and contact number to which a scholarship check would be sent.
3. The applicant must submit a resume detailing their involvement in extracurricular activities such as: school programs, religious activities, community activities or services, jobs and a detailed list of volunteer hours obtained while attending school.
4. The applicant must submit an essay (*essay subject located on the Application Form*). The essay **MUST** follow the format below to be accepted and should be sent in **Word or PDF**:
 - a. Maximum of 2 pages - typed.
 - b. 1.5-spaced.
 - c. Font - Calibri (Body).
 - d. Font size - 12 points.
 - e. Margins - set to 1 inch for all margins (top, bottom, left side, right side).
 - f. Page numbers should be .5 inch from the bottom of the page.
 - g. A header (*for example, the essay question*) can be added 1 inch from the top of the first page, and then enter a double space and begin your essay.
 - h. Do NOT use bold-faced type or other special settings.
 - i. The essay must follow the essay topic or be disqualified.
 - j. The essay and application will be judged on organization, depth of content, and clarity.
5. The applicable documents must be received via email by March 20, 2025.

6. **Any entry that does not meet ALL of these requirements will be disqualified, NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Additional rules:

1. Students must use the scholarship within one year of receiving it.
2. All scholarship checks will be written directly to the college and not to the students, NO EXCEPTIONS.

All applicants will be notified of the final scholarship selection by April 20, 2025. Upon receiving the scholarship, the winner releases all publicity rights to CHCH (photos, video, name correlating with scholarship) for use in promoting the scholarship program.
