#### **PREFACE**

This brochure is to assist you in your decision to run for the Board of Education. After the filing deadline, the superintendent and/or the board president will hold a brief orientation session for the candidates. The board administrative secretary will contact you with an invitation. The orientation will provide you with additional information about the school district and help inform you during your campaigning.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Alaska Statute 14.12.080 states, "To be eligible to be a member of a school board, a person must have the same qualifications as are necessary to be a municipal voter in the school district." That means you must be 18 years of age and maintain legal residence within the boundaries of the appropriate election district and the Kenai Peninsula Borough.

## TIME COMMITMENT

Serving as a Board of Education member requires a significant time commitment. Board members are elected for staggered three-year terms. Business meetings are held approximately 12 times a year, normally last one to three hours, and are generally on the first Monday of each month. Work sessions are usually held prior to each regular meeting, quarterly as needed and last between two to four hours. When necessary, the Board will also hold special meetings, e.g. when considering the budget or high priority needs. In addition, members serve on various Board and District committees and attend special school activities. These are not necessarily held on board meetings days. Additional time commitments may be required.

The board packets, which contain materials to be considered or acted on during formal business meetings, are posted on the District's BoardDocs portal <a href="http://www.boarddocs.com/ak/kpbsd/Board.nsf/public">http://www.boarddocs.com/ak/kpbsd/Board.nsf/public</a>. Reading this material can take between one to four hours. In addition, you will spend time reading email messages and listening to constituent concerns.

#### TRAVEL

The Board holds most regular board meetings at the Borough Administration Building in Soldotna. However, the Board holds one meeting per year in Homer and one in Seward. Board members are encouraged to visit each school in their district at least once during the school year.

#### RESPONSIBILITIES

- Select a district superintendent and appoint all certified school employees upon the recommendation of the superintendent or designee.
- Develop and adopt policies that govern the operation of the District.
- Provide leadership in establishing current and long-range educational plans and programs.
- Adopt an annual budget.
- Serve as the citizen's link to the school district.

### **COMPENSATION**

Board members receive a salary of \$300 per month. The board president receives a salary of \$400 per month.

Board members are eligible for coverage by the school district health and accident insurance and, possibly, the State of Alaska Public Employees Retirement System (PERS). If you are interested in determining your eligibility for PERS, contact the District's finance department.

Travel expenses for all Board meetings and functions are covered. Mileage is currently reimbursed at the rate of \$.625 per mile and is based on the government standard rate.

#### REWARDS

The rewards for serving in an elected position differ from person-to-person. However, the following might pertain to you:

- the enjoyment of working for children,
- the service provided for your community,
- the sense of accomplishment when District schools receive outstanding recognition,
- the experience of making decisions that have a positive impact on the education of thousands of students.

#### **CHALLENGES**

- Pressures from special interest groups.
- The impossibility of being all things to all people.
- The necessity of making decisions that may be unpopular.

## **DISTRICT CHARACTERISTICS**

The KPBSD is comprised of 42 school programs in 21 communities. School size varies from the small schools at Hope and Cooper Landing to over 500 students at Soldotna High School. The district encompasses 25,600 square miles and serves close to 8,500 students.
