KPBSD is analyzing the impact of this proposed \$20.9 million reduction in state education funding. Staffing, programs, sports, class size, school consolidation, district supports, pools, theaters ... are all areas for potential cuts in KPBSD to solve unprecedented funding reductions. Participate in community budget meetings. Be involved.



In addition to under-funding the Foundation Formula in FY20, and repealing the FY20 one-time funding to school districts, other proposed state budget items and proposed bills could impact school district education funding, including SB57. The Borough FY20 funding is yet to be determined. The KPBSD is analyzing additional impacts, and must pass a FY20 budget on April 1, 2019.
