	<p>Students will understand...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>That learning prefixes and suffixes enhances decoding, spelling ability, and vocabulary development.</li> <li>That reading should occur with purpose and understanding.</li> <li>That fluency, accuracy, and rate is developed over successive readings, with multiple opportunities to practice (silently and orally).</li> <li>That context is used to confirm and self-correct reading to develop understanding.</li> </ul>	<p>Students will keep considering...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>How do readers construct meaning?</li> <li>Why do readers read?</li> <li>How does reading add meaning to your life?</li> <li>How do readers adapt when text becomes more complex?</li> </ul>

<p>Students will know...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>How to show what they have learned about letters and sounds by figuring out words.</li> <li>How to find and tell the meaning of most common prefixes and suffixes.</li> <li>How to read words with common Latin suffixes.</li> <li>How to read words with more than one syllable.</li> <li>How to read third grade words that aren't spelled the way they sound.</li> <li>How to fluently read and understand books at their level.</li> <li>How to read and understand third grade books.</li> <li>How to read third grade books and poems aloud like a teacher would read them aloud.</li> </ul>	<p>Students will be skilled at...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recognizing and understanding irregular words.</li> <li>Decoding and defining words with common prefixes and suffixes and multisyllabic words.</li> <li>Reading grade-appropriate irregularly spelled words.</li> <li>Engaging in multiple experiences with reading texts (prose and poetry) at an independent level.</li> <li>Processing language for meaning and enjoyment.</li> <li>Developing fluency to focus attention on the meaning of the text.</li> </ul>
