A. Proposed changes to admission gate fees

Adults \$8.00 **\$10**

Seniors (over 65) \$5.00

Students \$2.00 **\$3.00**

Preschool Free if accompanied by a parent

Families \$20.00

Parents of Home Team \$2.00 **\$3.00** per parent, per game

President Settlemyer brought the topic of increasing suggested gate fees after looking at what other districts are charging and also our district's current fiscal outlook. The

rationale is based on the uncertainty of the different budget scenarios being presented at the district level and what the next school year will look like. Potential changes are possible with activity funding. This is not a dramatic increase, flexibility will still exist at the school level. The board discussed the topic and noted they do not want the gate to be prohibitive to event attendance. It was also noted a couple more dollars for programs is a minor change.
