

## Young American Creative Patriotic Art Contest

## A VFW Auxiliary National Scholarship **2024-2025**

The VFW National Auxiliary is pleased to present this National Scholarship to assist students who wish to further their education. This scholarship contest recognizes young artists and encourages patriotism in youth. Entries will be judged on originality of concept, presentation and patriotism expressed, content of how it relates to patriotism and clarity of ideas, design technique, total impact of work.

#### **Contest Eligibility**

- Student does not have to be related to a VFW or VFW Auxiliary member to participate.
- Students in grades 9-12 by the March 31 deadline who are enrolled in a public, private, parochial, or home school program in the United States, its territories and possessions, or dependents of U.S. military or civilian personnel in overseas schools.
- Although U.S. citizenship is not required, students must be lawful U.S. permanent residents or have applied for permanent residence (the application for which has not been denied) and intends to become a U.S. citizen.
- Foreign exchange students, students aged 20 or older, GED and adult education students are NOT eligible.
- Previous winners of VFW Auxiliary National Young American Creative Patriotic Art Contests are NOT eligible.

#### Contest Rules

- Entry must be completed during the current school year.
- Entry must be two dimensional.
- Entry must be on canvas or paper.
- Submit canvas entries on a stretcher frame or canvas board.
- Reinforce the back with heavy paper.
- Do not frame art with wood, metal, plastic or glass.
- Mats, including mounted and floating mats, may be used.
- Entries may not be smaller than 8" x 10" and not larger than 18" x 24", INCLUDING mat.
- Watercolor, pencil, pastel, charcoal, tempera, crayon, acrylic, pen, ink, oil, marker or other media may be used.
- If the American Flag is used, it must conform to the Federal Flag Code in relation to colors, number of stars and stripes and other pertinent rules of the code.
- Complete typed explanation of the entry (250 words or less) and attached to back of entry.
- Complete contest application and attached to back of entry.
- Parent or guardian signature required on contest application.
- Digital art and photography are not accepted.

#### **VFW Auxiliary National Scholarships**

First place - \$15,000
Second place - \$7,500
Third place - \$3,500
Fourth and Fifth place \$1,500
Sixth and Seventh \$1,000
Eighth through Nineteenth place - \$500

VFW Auxiliary is not responsible for incomplete, lost, late, misdirected entries. All scores are final as received from the judges.

Falsifying information on the entry form is reason for immediate disqualification. All contestants agree to abide by the contest rules.

Any violation of these rules shall be cause for immediate disqualification and forfeiture of award.

#### VFW Auxiliary judging and deadlines

- March 31: Student entries must be submitted to a participating sponsoring VFW Auxiliary for judging.
- April 15: One winner from each VFW Auxiliary advances to the VFW Auxiliary Department (state).
- May 5: VFW Auxiliary Department (state) winners due to VFW Auxiliary National Headquarters.
- July/August: Students will be notified of entry status via email provided on entry form. First through twelfth place winners named on VFW Auxiliary social media pages and displayed at the VFW Auxiliary National Convention.
- September: Art will be returned to students address on entry form.

Scholarships are paid directly to the American college, vocational, technical or trade school of the winners' choice.
