2. Recipients can attend any accredited institution of higher education, including Vocational Training.
3. Recipients will receive a “Certificate of Award” only. The student is to acquire confirmation of attendance from the Registrar of the college, university, or vocational school they are attending and submit to the Financial Secretary of the Emblem Club, at the address on the ‘**Certificate of Award.**’ The full amount of the scholarship will then be sent, by check, to the Registrar and payable to the institution.
4. A recipient of this scholarship may apply for one additional scholarship the following year.
5. Awards will be based on, (in no order): Community Service and involvement, educational goals, leadership abilities, financial need, Academic Achievement, awards and recognitions, and completeness, neatness, timeliness.
6. Please submit the following:
 - A. Two letters of recommendation, other than family and no more than one from a school official.
 - B. Copy of grades/transcripts, and equivalent life experiences.
 - C. Personal Statement/Scholarship Essay: (no less than 250 words) The statement/essay should include personal history, professional goals, how a scholarship can benefit you, why you should be awarded a scholarship.
