April 30th, 2026 by the end of the school day. No exceptions.

Rules of Eligibility for Ninilchik Domestic Engineers Club.

Community Achievement Award

1. Applicant, their parent(s) or legal guardian(s) must reside within the Ninilchik School boundaries during the school year.
2. Applicant must be a graduating senior from public or private secondary school, or Home school program (per boundaries in rule 1.)
3. A student will be defined as a person taking 1 or more credit hours in a semester.
4. Awards are for students to be able to advance to the next phase of life and prosper in their career choice.
5. A copy of your official high school transcripts must be submitted (attach paperwork with this application) to verify attendance and credits. Transcripts must include the first semester of your senior year.
6. Applicant must have a minimum of 45 hours verifiable lifetime Community Service of which 5 hours must be contributed to Ninilchik Domestic Engineer Club community service projects (list of opportunities is attached).
7. Applicant must submit an application and personal narrative entitled, "Who am I and what does this money mean to me" Personal narrative should be double-spaced, in size 12 font and not to exceed 2 pages.
8. Applicant must include 3 letters of recommendation. one from each category:
(1) A classroom teacher; (2) a community, industry member, or employer; (3) a personal reference. Each letter must reference the category the recommendation it is intended to fulfill.
9. An interview may be required; we will notify you if interview is necessary.
10. Application and requirements must be received by the N.D.E. representative no later than April 30th-2026.
11. The decision of the Community Achievement Award committee is final.
