Board of Education Meeting News In Brief

WORKSESSION REPORT: The Board held two worksessions prior to the formal business meeting which included the FY10 budget and superintendent vacancy. The Board conducted a conference call with Kenai Peninsula legislators and held a discussion with KPAA, KPEA, and KPESA presidents regarding the superintendent vacancy.

AWARDS AND PRESENTATIONS: The Board recognized Miss Katherine Dolma, Homer Middle School student, for being selected as one of two top youth volunteers for Alaska for 2009 by the Prudential Spirit of Community Awards.

The Board presented Golden Apple Awards to Marilyn Dvorak, Homer Flex Custodian; Laureen Wentz, Homer Flex Aide; Laura Norton, Homer Flex Secretary; and Nancy Vait, Homer Flex Teacher for their service to Homer Flex students.

SCHOOL REPORT: Mr. Benny Abraham, Paul Banks Elementary principal, Mrs. Sharon Schulz, special services teacher, and Kathy Eller, interventionist, gave a PowerPoint presentation highlighting Response to Intervention and the Visualizing and Verbalizing Program by Nancy Bell.

Ms. Sheryl Hingley, Susan B. English Elementary/High School principal/teacher, reported on how the school is helping students be successful through the implementation of the intervention program, use of the distance education program, delivery of classes in music, art, chemistry, dance and theater, foreign language, and vocational education. She introduced contemporary band students, Matthew Gain, Jordan Geagel, Darin Baines and Lily Kroll, who performed two songs led by Rob Rurka, band teacher.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT: Dr. Peterson reported that Dr. Atwater is in Juneau for Alaska Association of School Administrators annual Legislative Fly-In. She thanked Homer High for hosting the Board meeting. She announced that the community budget forums begin on March 3; principal interviews begin with West Homer Elementary on March 3; the end of the quarter is Friday, March 5; Spring Break begins March 16 through 20; and that Alan Fields, Kenai Central High School principal was selected as Alaska High School Principal of the Year by the Alaska Association of Secondary School Principals.

FISCAL YEAR 2009 BUDGET: Mrs. Douglas presented the 2009-2010 Preliminary Draft School District budget of \$123,739,902 for the General Fund and special revenue funds totaling \$18,085,300 for a total of \$141,825,202 for all funds.

FINANCIAL REPORT: Mrs. Douglas presented the financial report of the District for the period ending January 31, 2009.

SUPERINTENDENT SEARCH COMMITTEE REPORT: Mr. Arness provided an update on the progress of the superintendent search and reported that at present, five completed applications have been submitted. The Board unanimously approved the prescreening of superintendent candidate applications by all Board members beginning March 9 at 5:00 p.m. through March 10 at 12:00 p.m. Each member will submit a choice of five candidates to interview to the Human Resources Department. A consensus of applicants will be invited to interview (either in

person or telephonically) on March 11, beginning at 10:00 a.m. The public was invited to provide comments, either verbal or written. No comments were made.
