A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING RECOGNITION OF SCHOOL PRINCIPALS AS INSTRUCTIONAL LEADERS

WHEREAS, during the 1998 session, passage of CSSB36 signaled the legislative intent for districts to reduce non-instructional expenditures, and

WHEREAS, as 14.17.520 requires that "a district shall budget for and spend a minimum of 70 percent of its school operating expenditures in each fiscal year on the instructional component of the district budget", and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Education and Early Development has interpreted the statute to exclude expenditures for school principals from the instructional component, and


WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District Board of Education recognizes the inherent instructional leadership that principals provide, and

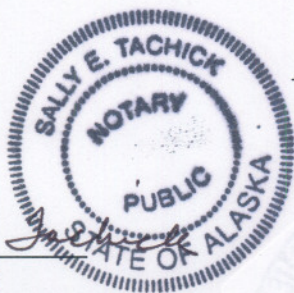
WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough School District goal to expend 70 percent in instructional categories would be met and exceeded,


