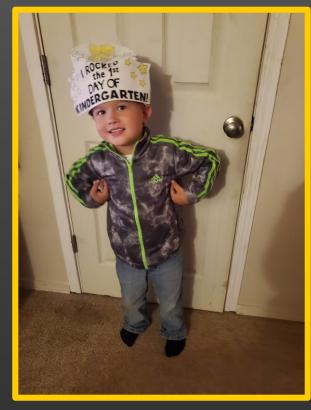

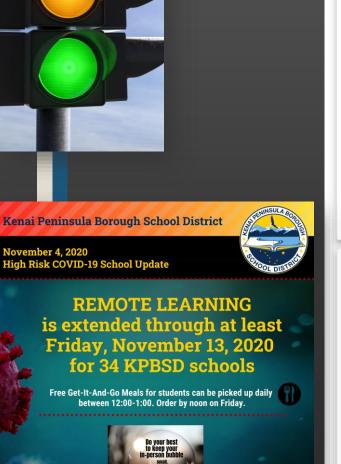

Kenai Peninsula K-12 School Operations COVID-19 Risk Levels

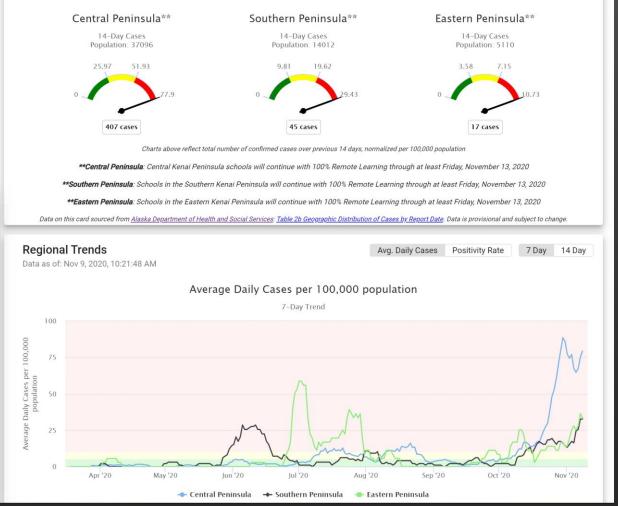
14-Day Cases Avg Daily Incidence

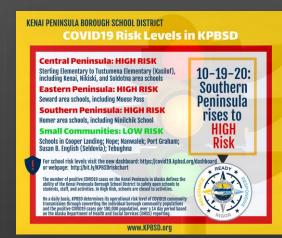
Overview By Case/Incidence Rate

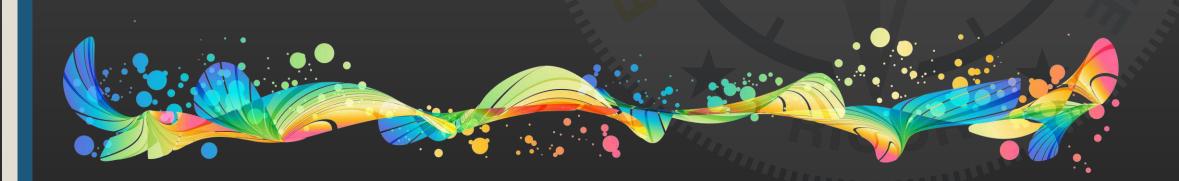
- Q:How can KPBSD safely bring students to schools for onsite learning during "Red" High COVID-19 Risk?
