



Process Update

- January 14: FY19 Revision and Preliminary FY20 Budget introduction
- Borough: Request monthly Assembly work sessions beginning January 22
- February to March: Multiple opportunities for input
 - ► February 19: Homer HS
 - ► February 20: Soldotna HS
 - ► February 21: Kenai Central HS
 - ► February 26: Seward HS

April 1: FY20 budget approval by School Board – transmitted to Borough





Clarity

- Pupil Teacher Ratio was NOT adjusted for FY19
- Certified Staff reductions were function of declining enrollment in FY17 and FY18

Since FY15 reductions of over \$7 million

- 10 District Office positions
- Curriculum, Supplies, Travel
- Student Nutrition Services
- Certified staff adjustments
- Custodians for FY18
