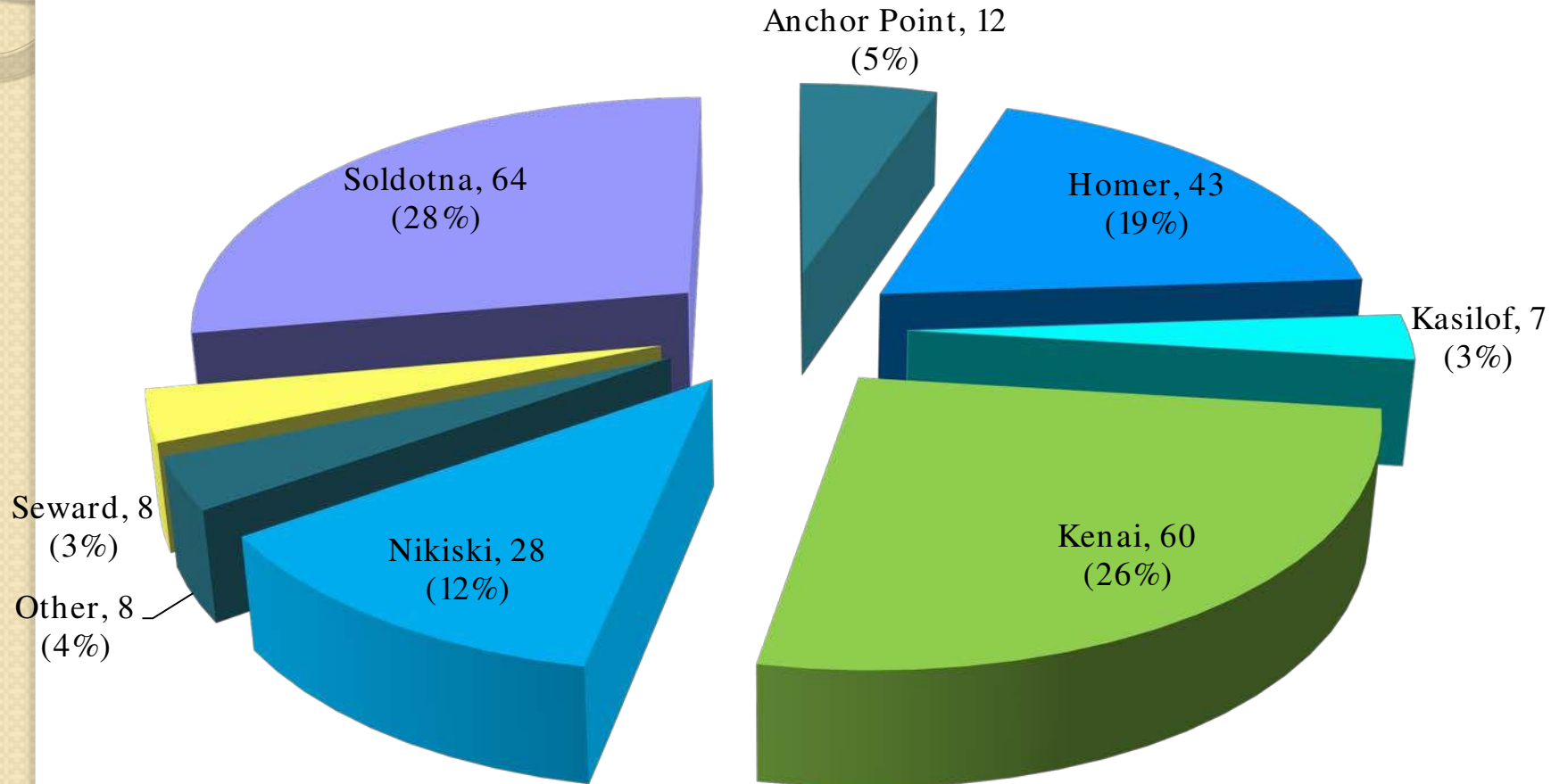

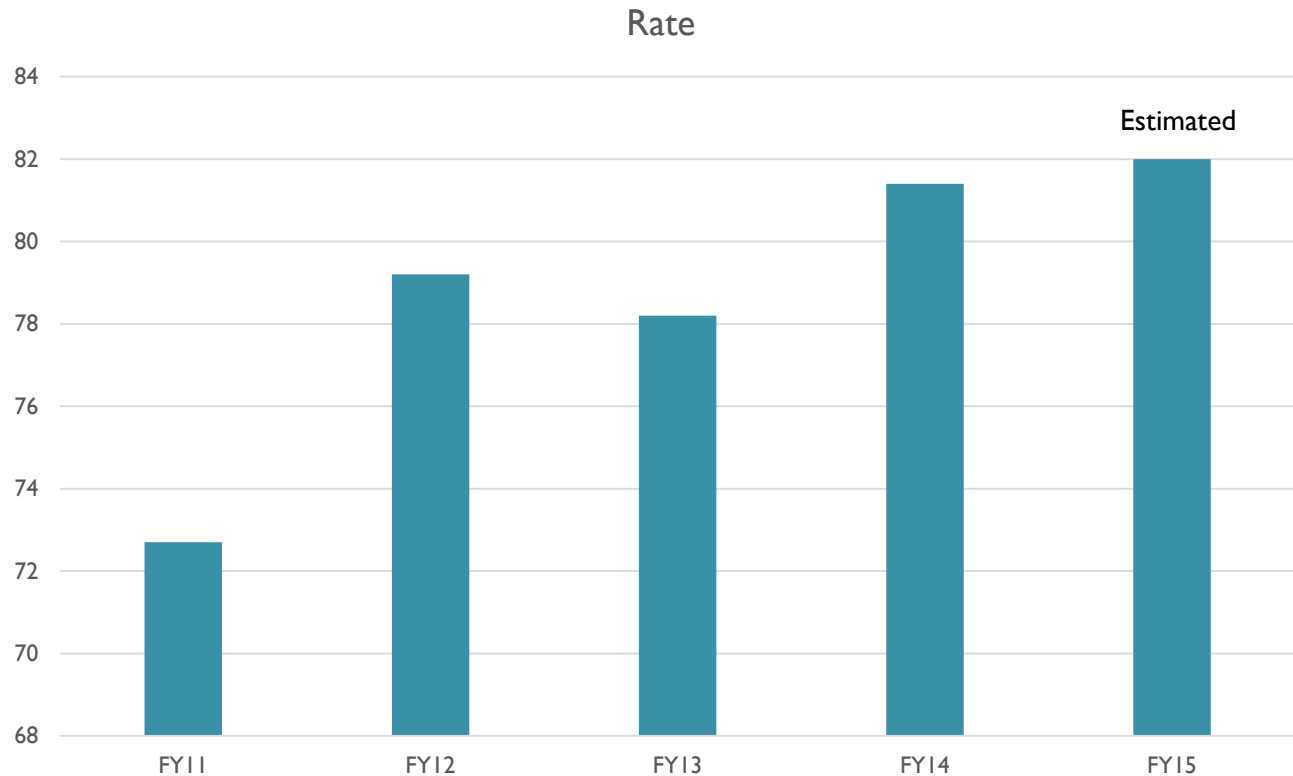

- Approved reductions (\$ 1,800,275)
- Approved expenditures \$165,639,198
- Revenues \$157,477,453
 - State – One-Time cut
 - State – Senate cut
 - Borough - \$44m
- Deficit (\$ 8,161,745)
- Fund Balance
 - Health Care – (\$2,611,341)
 - Unassigned - (\$5,550,404)

Bottom Line

- We continue to use our reserves and with the late adjustment by the legislature, more than we had planned in February
- Reserves have allowed us to present a balanced budget and more importantly provide stability to students, staff and community
- Discussion on next year's possible legislative adjustments already being discussed – expect larger cuts as State fiscal plan becomes clearer for FY17
- This will reduce the amount of possible Borough Assistance
- Reduction in services for FY16 due to PTR adjustment, district-wide reductions, operational reductions
- Goal of maintaining consistent level of service for District's students will require use of reserves.
