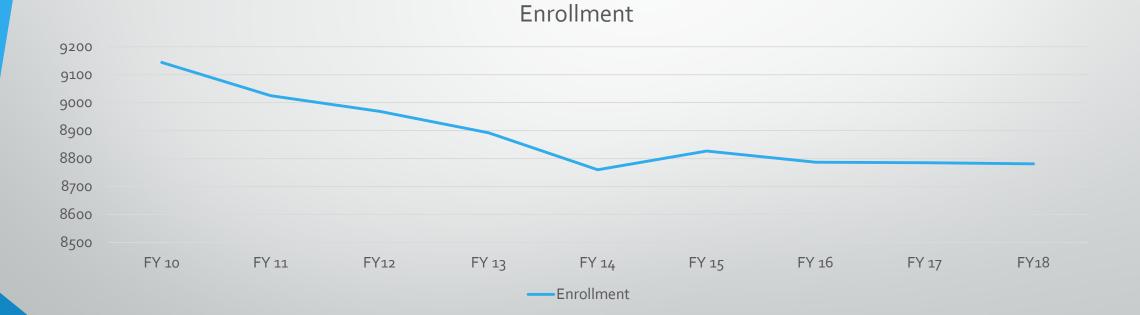

District Enrollment from FY10



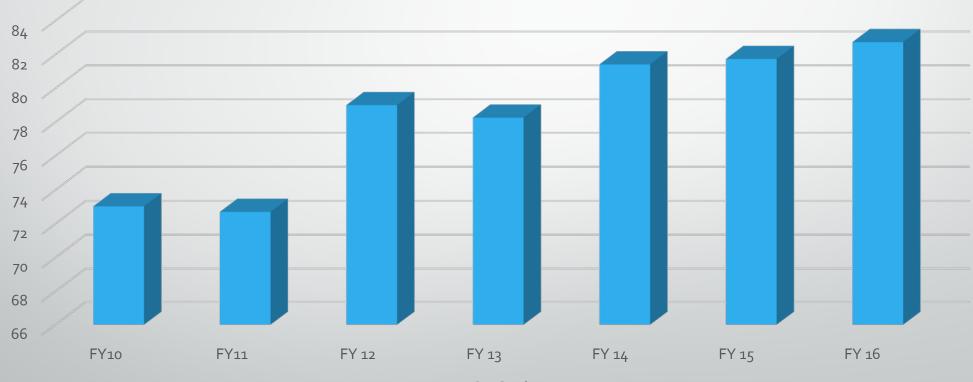
Current Enrollment by Grade

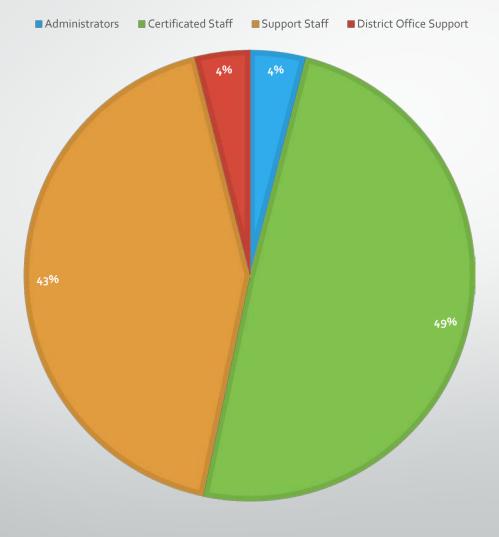

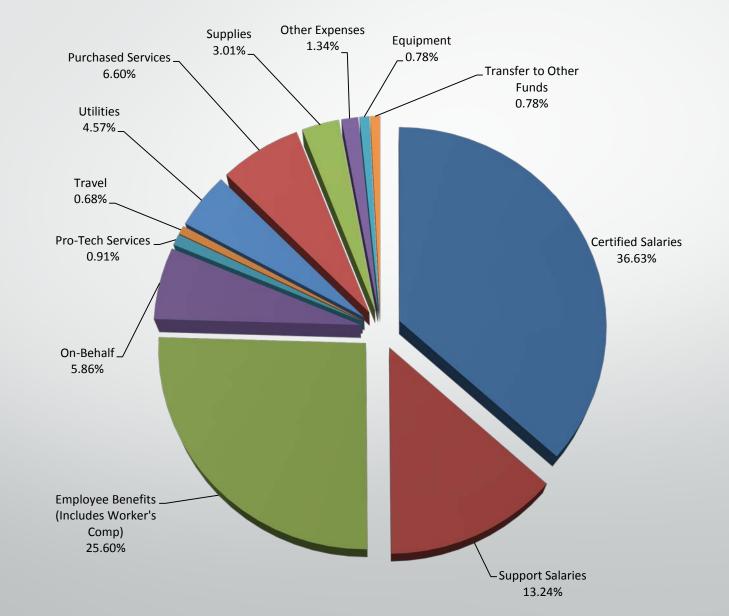
Finances

Health Care Costs have increased 57% since 2010

Budget

- FY15: \$1,147,325 deficit (after \$1,254,000 in budget reductions)
- FY16: \$1,137,600 deficit (after \$1,375,000 in budget reductions)
- FY17: \$2,241,628 deficit (after \$2,534,393 in budget reductions)
 - Also an additional \$900,000 in lapse included beyond listed reductions
- FY18: \$3,452,580 deficit anticipate using \$1,132,338 in fund balance remaining deficit is \$2,320,242

Reduction Details

- FY15: Increased all certificated staffing formulas by .5 (8 FTE), DO staffing (1 FTE), Technology/Supplies/Software/Utilities/Travel
- FY16: Right Sized Elementary school staffing and increased secondary formulas (6.8 FTE), Pool and Distance Education restructure (2.0 FTE),Travel/Curriculum/Utilities
- FY17: DO staff (5.26 FTE), Counselor and School Admin. staffing (2.0 FTE), DO supplies/travel/Pro Tech/Software, Food Service, Lapse, Enrollment reductions (13.0 FTE)
- FY18: Reviewing District Office services, Staffing formulas, School Support formulas, Travel, Curriculum supplies and any other areas of efficiency
