
District Enrollment FY10 - FY18




Budget

- FY17 Deficit \$1.3 million
- ► Since FY15 reductions of over \$7 million
 - ▶ 10 District Office positions
 - Curriculum, Supplies, Travel
 - Student Nutrition Services (SNS)
 - ► Certified staff adjustments in FY15, FY16 mainly due to enrollment
 - Custodians for FY18
- **▶** Process

Maslow then Bloom




Bloom's Taxonomy = levels of thinking
