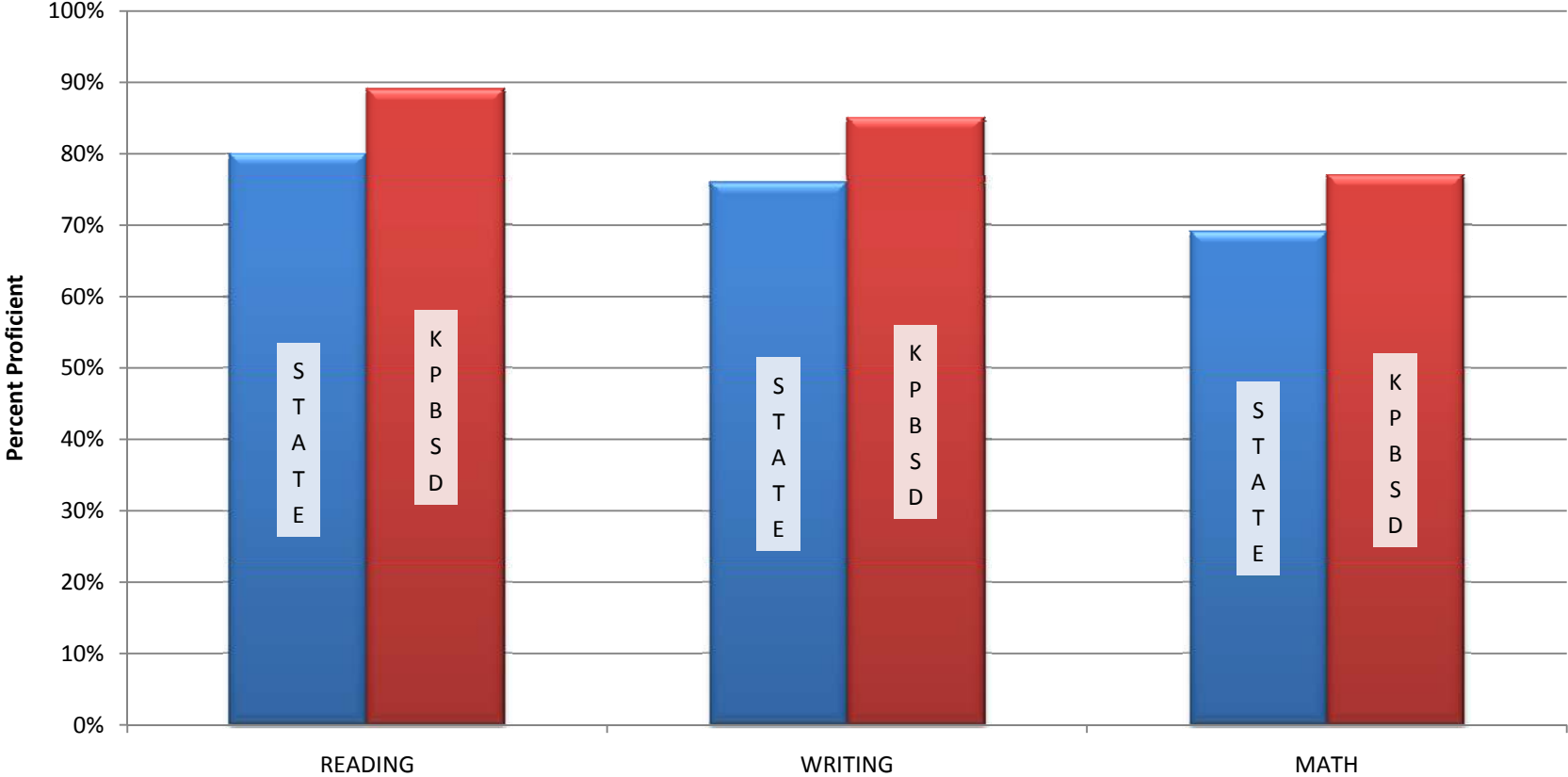

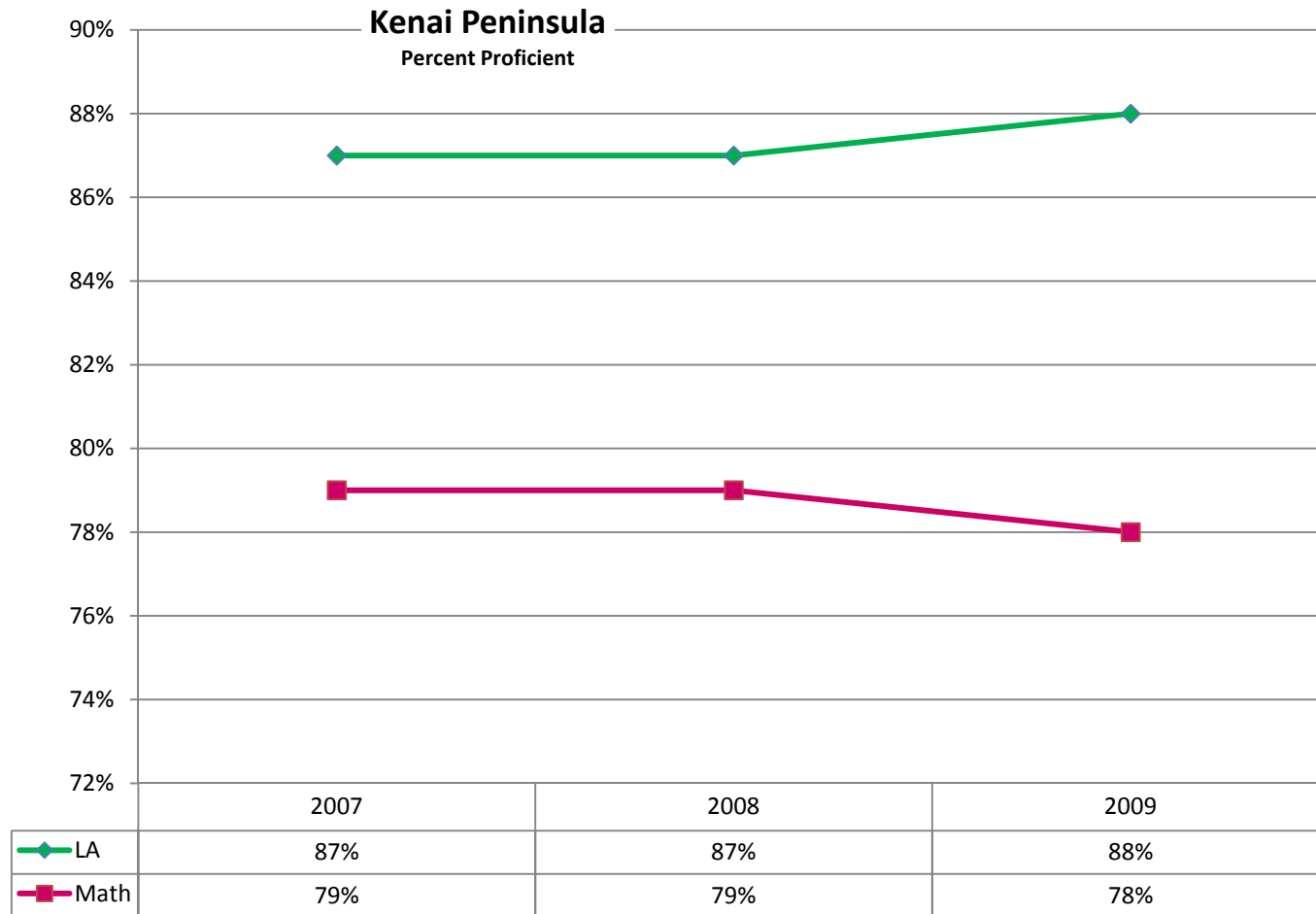

Last Year's SBA Scores

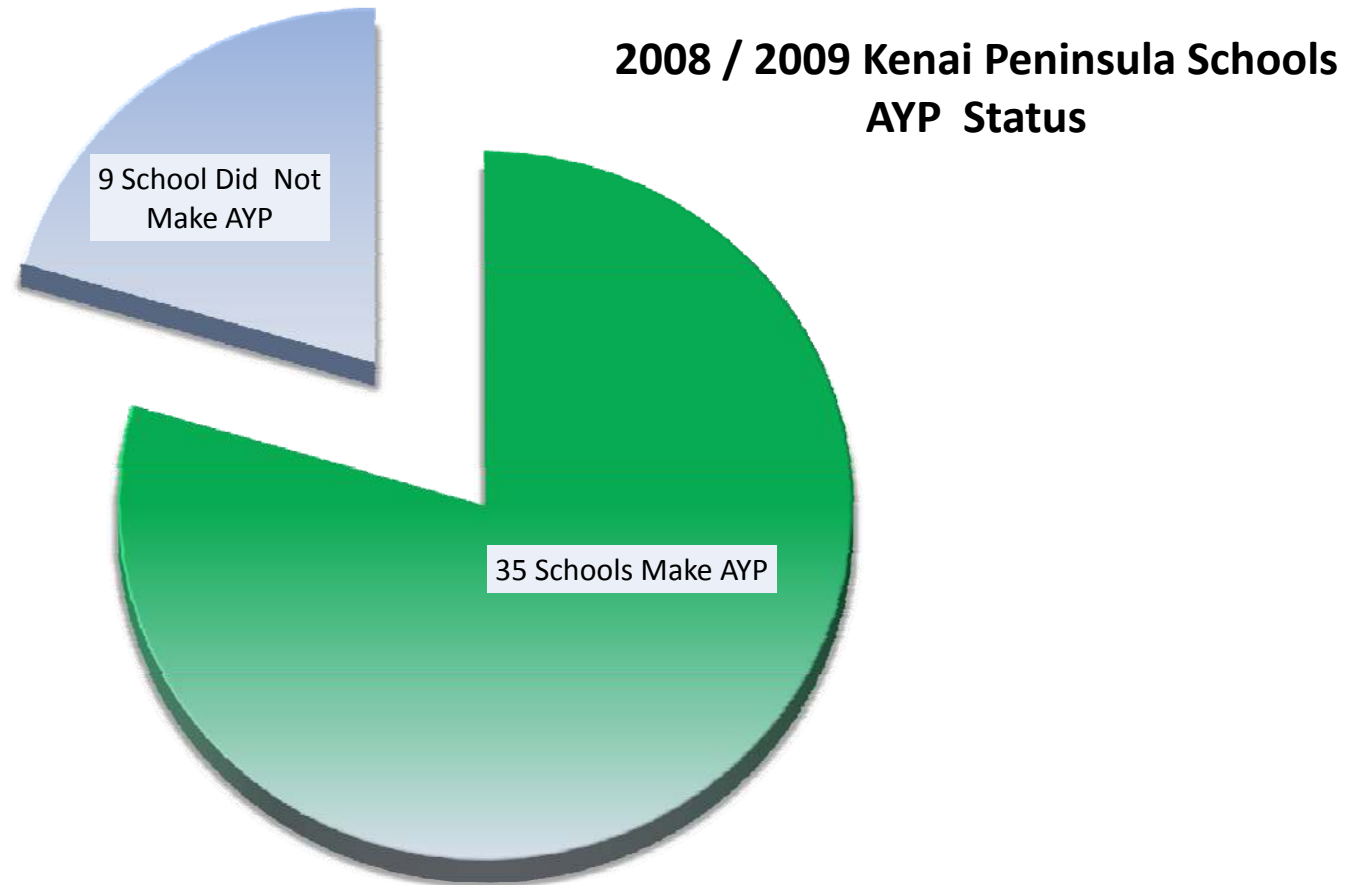
KPBSD & STATE AVERAGES of 2009 SBA



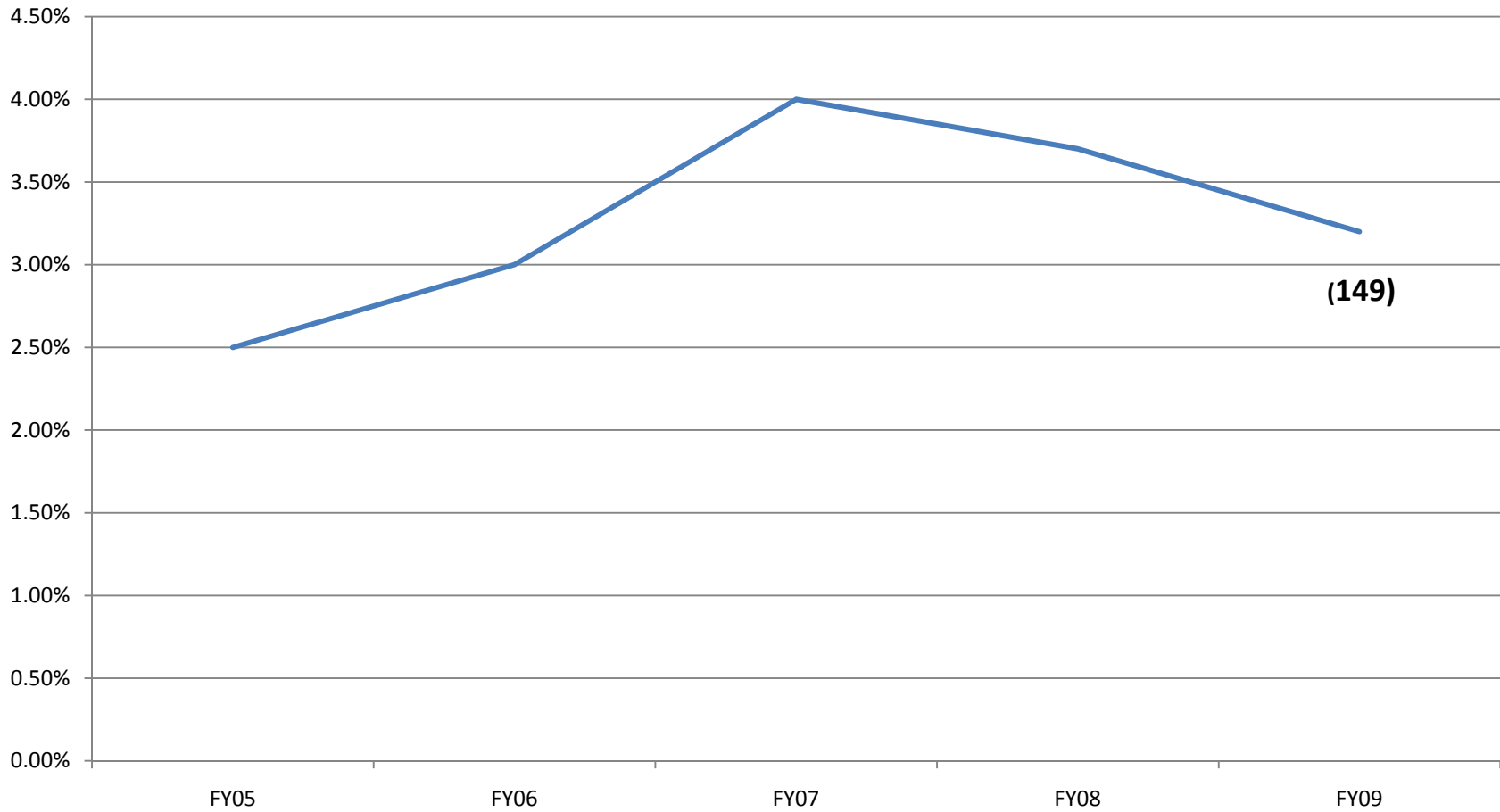
SBA Proficiency Trend Data
